Each of these relations and identities is formed through empirical human activities as those activities are required within that unity of production, distribution, exchange, and consumption and as these represent particular forms of production and reproduction of human existence. These extend to the tiers associated with the production of raw materials for the electronics industry, which in mobile phone production notably include the mineral coltan.

Production furnishes the object for consumption, but there is no production. Such an organization involves a clearly defined coordinating hierarchy but eliminates a power hierarchy. Investment is the engine of growth.

Manuel Castells argues that social space becomes primarily an area of consumption. Goods are typically defined only in reference to the good itself but, as this book argues, the public goods can be better understood if contextual variables are incorporated.
